We have also been invited to stage a pair of MathSpeak conferences in India during August 2014 – a great opportunity to reach the largest education market in the world.

### Scope:

For delegates the conferences will cover the latest developments in teaching 14 to 19 Mathematics and Numeracy cohort including curriculum and assessment. Recent changes to Qualification specifications and delivery, and new technological developments, will be focus areas.
